

NJTRAx 2.0 – Digital Learning



Digital learning surveys and reporting capabilities have been added to the NJTRAx interactive technology readiness data and reporting system in order to assist districts with developing digital learning environments.

Districts and schools will now have the ability to track and strategically plan for digital learning policies and practices. NJTRAx DL provides six surveys covering the eight gears that are critical for digital learning.
